Dinosaur play-dough footprints!

Can you make a dinosaur world? What dinosaurs will you have?

1. Encourage your child to roll out and flatten the play-dough so that they have a surface to work on.



2. Then print either dinosaur bones or footprints of into the play-dough.

Science

Dinosaur volcano!

 Place a small cup in the centre of your tray or container.



- 2. Display some toy dinosaurs around the edges of this tray/container. Create a scenery of dinos who are eating and living happily.
- 3. Now, sprinkle some bicarbonate of soda onto your scene. Be sure to get a lot into your cup!
- 4. Mix a small amount of red food dye into some vinegar, and then get your child to help tip the vinegar into the bicarbonate of soda volcano. It will fizz up and spill over the edges, flowing down to meet the dinosaurs.

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
