


Home Learning Ideas – Autumn 2

In WW2 food was rationed. That means you could only buy a certain amount.



Make a display to show what you could buy and how much you were allowed to buy.



Make a WW2 meal using only the ingredients you could buy during WW2.



Or, you could make a WW2 cake from the ingredients you were allowed to buy.

Find out the difference between an Anderson Shelter and a Morrison Shelter – show the difference using an annotated diagram.



(Could even make a model instead.)

Big cities were bombed badly in WW2. Choose a big city in England and find out what happened to it in WW2.



During WW2, Vera Lynn was a famous singer. She sang songs to help the people at war feel hopeful and good.



Find the lyrics (words) of one of her songs. Listen to it in the Internet. What was it about? What words do you think helped people?


