
Summer Term (A) Home Learning

There are 54 countries on the continent of Africa. Choose one of these countries and explore it. Make an expert board.

Think about the food, the animals, the countryside, the music, the clothes...



We have started to look at the instruments and sounds that come from the continent of Africa.

Make a shaker. Think about what you are going to put inside to make the sound. You could try making two shakers with both making a different sound to the other.

If you were to design a safari park, what animals would you have? Design a safari park. Think about what habitat each animal needs to survive.

For example, monkeys like to swing through trees.




Don't forget to include toilets, gift shops, paths, etc.

Food in Africa is very different to the food we might eat. Just like in Europe, each country in Africa has its own special dish.



Find out what ingredients people in Africa use in their food. Design a meal using these ingredients. Either draw and annotate a picture of your meal or make it and take a photo. We have been looking at how a person's needs change over the years from when they are a baby to an elderly person.

You need to produce a guide in how to look after a baby. It needs to be like an instruction manual. Use pictures and writing.



You could ask your mum or dad, or another relative like an aunt or uncle that have a baby. A south Saharan village is very different to a village we would see in England.

Make a model of a south Saharan village (or just a hut).

You could look on the Internet for ideas.
