We are learning about the capital cities in the UK. Have you visited any of these capital cities? You can create a fact page about the capital city you have visited. Why not research London? Who lives there? What would you see if you visited London? Where do tourists go? Be creative and tell us the best places to visit.



Belfast is the capital city of Northern Ireland.
Cardiff is the capital city of Wales.
Edinburgh is the capital city of Scotland.
London is the capital city of England.

In Science, you are looking at plants. See if you can grow a new plant from an old plant. Many vegetables can be grown from just a part of a vegetable. For example, carrot tops and potatoes.



Here are some of the common vegetables (and herbs) that you can re-grow from scraps:

- Potatoes
- Sweet Potatoes
- Onions, Garlic, Leeks and Shallots
- Celery
- Bulb Fennel
- Carrots, Turnips, Parsnips, Beets and Other Root Crops
- Lettuce, Bok Choi and Other Leafy Greens
- Cabbages

Draw a picture or pattern using different 2-D shapes. In your picture or pattern, you should use a circle (1), a triangle (3), a square (4), a rectangle (4), a pentagon (5), a hexagon (6), a heptagon (7), an octagon (8), a nonagon (9) and a decagon (10).

You can use them as many times as you like.
