



Maths: We will be looking at place value (rounding numbers, placing numbers on number lines); looking at how to accurately measure perimeters and length; calculating using addition and subtraction, and multiplication and division using formal and informal methods. We will be using the concepts we learn in maths to solve problems and investigations.

Science: We will be exploring matter— States of matter (solids, liquids, gases). We will be investigating evaporation and condensation. We will be investigating how water temperature changes as its state changes. We will be using scientific reasoning to make decisions.

English: We will be using the book Maroo of the Winter Caves by Ann Turnbull. We will be following the journey of Maroo across mountains and ice—sheets. We will be exploring her family and how they survived in such harsh conditions. We will be experiencing the dangers with Maroo, how she gets lost and how in the end she survives and makes it back home to her tribe. We will be writing parts of our own narrative using historical context.

Exploring adverbs, verbs, adjectives, alliteration, similes and metaphors. Looking at sentence structures and punctuation.

Spellings and reading.

Religious Education: We will be looking at the Hindu religion, finding out what they believe and all about their different gods. We will be exploring how they worship their gods, especially the Puja Tray and the effect of their gods on everyday life. Christmas: different traditions.
