Nursery Rhymes

We will be using the stories to:

- Recognise rhyming words
- Perform and re-enact
- Recall the order of events

The Gingerbread Man. We will be using a recipe to make our own gingerbread men biscuits. We will also have a go at using our imagination to find different ways to help the Gingerbread Man to cross the river.

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Key Questions.

- How can we help the Gingerbread man cross the river safely?
- Which animals make their own homes?
- Is it the same wolf in the Three Little Pigs and Red Riding Hood?
