



Remote Learning Plan and Timetable

Remote Learning if your child is a member of a bubble that has been sent home to self-isolate

If a Bubble has been sent home to self-isolate due to a confirmed case of COVID in that class, the immediate class teacher and Teaching Assistants will manage the work for the Bubble while they are off using Microsoft Teams, the VLE, videos and online resources. Our aim is to mirror the learning in school so the children at home receive a similar curriculum. The teacher will be able to deal with any issues swiftly as they will also be self-isolating and will have the capacity to respond during school hours to any questions.

If a Bubble is sent home to self-isolate, but the teacher is unwell, other members of staff and Senior Leadership Team will manage the learning for those sent home. These teachers will still have their own classes to teach, therefore they will not be able to plan in the same detail or respond to questions as quickly. They will do their best to support the children learning at home, but they will have limited time available.

If individual children are self-isolating because another family member has been tested positive, again the class teacher will manage the learning via the VLE. They will still be teaching the rest of the class, so have limited time available, but will try to respond to any questions as quickly as they can. The same applies if the school is in lockdown but critical worker children or vulnerable children are still attending.

If your child is unwell we do not expect them to be following the attached timetable. They need to rest and get well.

Most Maths and English tasks will be set at the beginning of the week as part of live interactive sessions. These might be topped up during the week if the direct learning or skills need to be revisited.. Group sessions will be organised by the teacher and teaching assistant at different points on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday. There will also be surgery times on these days for pupils to contact the classteacher with any questions or concerns. This will be a set and limited time each day.

A timetable for these will be set up in liaison with the Senior Leadership Team and SENCo and shared with you as soon as possible. The core skills in Maths and English would be prioritised, however we would endeavour to set tasks that support the foundation subjects such as Art, History and P.E.

Maths and English books will be taken home by the child at the beginning of the isolation period and returned when the child returns. Work and links may also be uploaded to the VLE by the classteacher. You might also want to upload photographs or work to the VLE for the classteacher to see.

The classteacer will contact you via School Ping with the link to Microsoft Teams. We are aware that technology may be an issue at home, so we have tried to be as flexible as possible for the learning to take place over the week.

Depending what day the bubble is sent home, the first day of interactive teaching will start the following day.

In the event of a <i>full bubble or school closure</i> , teachers at Shoreham Beach will provide the following remote learning opportunities:
