**ART**

Which artists have included wolves in their pieces? Are they painted, collaged, sculpted? Can you recreate one you admire or make your own piece of wolf art work?



**SCIENCE**

What is the difference between a solid, liquid and gas? Can you try out an experiment at home and report back on your findings? There are plenty to be found on the internet.



**WRITING**

Can you write a story about wolves? Which stories in popular culture feature wolves? Maybe you can write an updated version of Red Riding Hood? We could read your story to the class.
