











Ocean Home Learning Spring 1

<p>Create a quiz on William Shakespeare. It must have at least 15 questions and an answer sheet. (I expect more than true or false!).</p> 	<p>Do some research on the time in which Shakespeare lived. What was different?</p> 	<p>Research the original Globe Theatre. When was it built? What happened to it? How much did it cost to see a show?</p> 	<p>Research one of Shakespeare's plays. What is the main story line? You may not choose Romeo and Juliet!</p> 
<p>Do two sketches of costumes from Romeo and Juliet. Label them carefully and include the fabric that they were made from. Remember to state the character!</p> 	<p>Design a 'set' for one of the scenes of Romeo and Juliet.</p> 	<p>Create a programme for a play of your choice.</p> 	<p>Find a key speech from a Shakespeare play (You may choose Romeo and Juliet if you wish). Can you learn some of it off by heart. You will need to perform it to the class and explain the meaning of the speech.</p>
<p>Research a play. Draw a comic strip of it. You can choose how to set it out, but you must include key scenes and full colour.</p> 	<p>Choose one of Shakespeare's plays. Design a DVD case or a poster of it. Set it out like a proper DVD case or Play poster, but it is up to you how you show the play. You choose actors.</p> 	<p>Write a newspaper article set in Shakespeare's time.
