

## Ocean Class Home Learning Spring 1

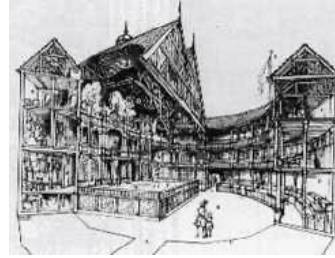

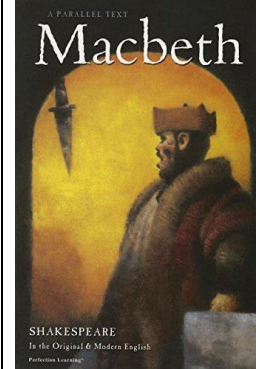
Do some research on the time in which Shakespeare lived. Compared to how we live now, what is the same and what is different?



Research the original Globe Theatre. When was it built? What happened to it? How much did it cost to see a show? Compared to visiting the theatre now, what is the same and what is different?



Research one of Shakespeare's plays. What is the main story line? Don't choose Romeo and Juliet, it'll give the game away for our classwork!



Do two sketches of costumes which could be used in a production of Romeo and Juliet. Label them carefully, including the materials you would make them from. Remember to state the character!



Design a 'set' for one of the scenes from Romeo and Juliet.



Create a programme for a play of your choice.



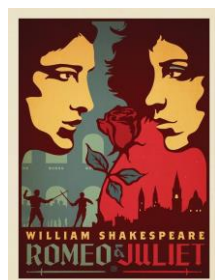
Find a key speech from a Shakespeare play (you may choose Romeo and Juliet if you wish) to perform. Can you memorise it? You could perform it to the class and explain the meaning of the speech.



Research a play. Draw a comic strip of it. You can choose how to set it out, but you must include key scenes and dialogue.



Choose one of Shakespeare's plays. Design a DVD case or a poster of it. Set it out like a proper DVD case or movie poster, but it is up to you how you show the play.



Write a newspaper article set in Shakespeare's time. Write about something to do with one of his plays.
